COMMUNITY



In 1812, The Township of Chardon, Ohio was formally established from the land now encompassing Chardon Township and Chardon City and became one of 24 townships within the county. At that time, Geauga County also included land that later became Lake County. In 1851, the Village of Chardon separated from the Township and became incorporated. With the 2000 census figure exceeding 5,000, the Village automatically became the City of Chardon on April 29, 2001.

Today Chardon remains to many, a town rich in history and culture. Its public square (where the church is located) is surrounded by government offices and quaint shops and many activities and events are still held there throughout the year.

CHARDON LOCAL SCHOOLS



In the past, Chardon has been considered to be a well off community with little to no needs. In recent years there has been an alarming increase in poverty, needed assistance, and mental health needs. Chardon local schools has consistently identified students in crisis at every grade level. Through community partnerships, church collaboration, and working with the school we can help to make a difference.

Poverty

- 1 in 5 students in the Chardon school district is in poverty.
- Neglect and abuse is up 60%
- Families experiencing homelessness is up an alarming 300%
- Food assistance programs are needed

Assistance

- Students need assistance with:
- Shoes and clothing
 - Personal hygiene items
 - Assistance with purchasing yearbooks
 - Funds to go on field trips
 - Help cover fees for student enrichment activities

Mental Health

- Student referral for mental health services up 278%
- Students hospitalized due to suicide thought or attempt up 500%
- Suicide risk assessments up 92.86%
- Student threat assessments up 700%
